

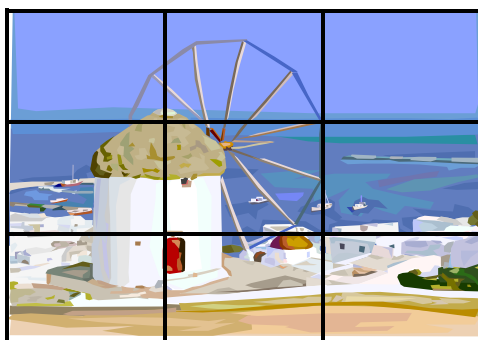


## **Guidelines and tips on photo entries:**

A picture tells a thousand words, and it takes a thousand to get a winner. Don't stop at the first photo you take – keep on trying till you capture what you have in mind.

Images should:

- ✓ be taken in high resolution
- ✓ be clear - for outside close up shots use the flash to minimise glare. Use a tripod or find something stable like a bench to avoid camera shake

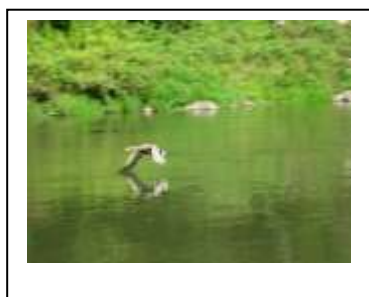


- ✓ Follow the *Rule of Thirds*. Imagine the photograph divided into nine equal parts. Ensure that the main subject is located around one of the intersection points rather than in the centre of the frame.

- ✓ be accompanied with a title that explains the photo **and** a short description (max. 150 words) of the investigation conducted on the photo.

Get familiar with all the features of your camera to get the best possible shot (e.g. a high shutter speed to capture fast action).

**Most importantly, make sure that your work is original. Any copied material will be automatically disqualified. Copying other peoples' work without permission is a serious offence!**
